George Allen has gotten hundreds of thousands from Big Oil while voting for Big Oil subsidies. **That's his idea of "Going Green."**

George Allen voted to give away \$6 billion to oil and gas companies in just one bill. Then \$13 billion in tax breaks to energy companies in another. (HR 6, Senate Vote 456, 11/21/03; HR 6, Senate Vote 158, 6/28/05)

All of this at a time when the Big Oil companies were enjoying massive profits.

Overall, Allen has taken more than \$1.4 million in contributions from energy special interests. During his last Senate campaign, the energy industry gave him more money than any other Senator except one. (Source: Center for Responsive Politics)

Since then, Big Oil and the energy special interests have spent hundreds of thousands more supporting his campaign. They EVEN paid his salary.

George Allen has been paid \$347,000 from his business that does consulting work for the energy industry. He made another \$20,000 running a group that is a project of an oil industry-funded think tank. (Washington Post, 8/14/09; Washington Post, 9/24/11)
