Huge campaign contributions. Allen has taken more than \$1.4 million in contributions from energy special interests, including Big Oil. The last time he ran for Senate, the energy industry gave him more money than any other Senator except one. More than Senators from Texas or Louisiana. Today, he's still near the top of the list. Huge consulting fees. George Allen has been paid \$347,000 from his business that does consulting work for the energy industry. He made another \$20,000 running a group that is a project of an oil industry-funded organization. (Washington Post, 8/14/09; Washington Post, 9/24/11)

Tim Kaine

Kaine supports “ending subsidies to oil companies as a way to curb the nation’s skyrocketing debt.” (Washington Post, 5/11/11)

Kaine supports a crackdown on Big Oil billionaires and corporations giving unregulated secret money to shadowy out of state groups that seek to influence Virginia elections.

As Governor, Kaine demonstrated true fiscal stewardship by cutting the state budget by more than \$3 billion, even reducing his own salary. Under Tim Kaine, Virginia was named the "Best State for Business" for four consecutive years.
